

Youth Protection Certification for Non-University Organizations and Entities Operating Activities Involving Minors

Youth Protection Training Requirements

All non-university organizations and entities that operate camps, programs, activities or events on campus involving minors must provide training to their staff consistent with the university's requirements, which includes the following topics:

- Appropriate conduct when interacting with, or in the presence of, minors;
- Child abuse and neglect prevention;
- Recognition of the signs and symptoms of child abuse and neglect; and
- Mandated reporter obligations, including reporting requirements and procedures.

Additionally, all individuals must read, understand and agree to abide by <u>USC's Guidelines for Interacting with Minors.</u>
